



Expected Attendance: We anticipate 200-250 attendees.

Amenities:

- Air conditioning
- Public restrooms
- Water fountains
- Handicap Accessible
- Parking options (limited parking spaces available in parking lot, in front of TVP residents' units, along Stringham Ct and Frankfort.)
- Free Wi-Fi access
- Electrical Outlets (limited availability)
- Classroom available for 30 minute presentations (will have to provide your own projector)
- Light breakfast (coffee and bagels) and lunch (beef/turkey hot dogs and chips) will be provided
- A table and two chairs per vendor

FOP Expectations of Vendors:

We expect our health fair vendors to:

- Arrive between 9:30a.m. 10:15 a.m. to set up their table/booth. You can unload your car at the front entrance of the TVP II Community Center. A Health fair volunteer will be available to assist you.
- Be responsible for the action and behavior of their employees and guest helpers
- Answer questions or concerns attendees may have
- Have a positive and welcoming attitude
- Bring their concerns or questions about the health fair to the FOP coordinator (Cescily Barnes)

Workshop Availability:

We have two available slots for workshops at this year's health fair. Vendors hosting a "workshop" (e.g. show videos, demonstrations, activities and etcetera) will have a great opportunity to speak to attendees and clearly convey the vendor's intended message.
